Great Location, and a Great Value

The Fall Press Day Conference is held at the Busch Campus Center, Rutgers University,

604 Bartholomew Road, Piscataway, NJ 08854, conveniently accessible from Routes 1 and 18, the NJ Turnpike and the Garden State Parkway.

The cost of the conference is reasonable: just \$20 per student and \$50 per adviser, which includes a one-year GSSPA membership.

Registration now has three steps:

- 1 Complete the online registration form by October 24: (the form will be available by September 1) The online form is the official registration.
 - The paper form is to accompany the payment as an identifier.
- 2 You will receive a registration code number by email within 24 hours.
- 3 Using the registration code, complete a copy of the paper form for each adviser and <u>mail with payment</u>.

Schedule info:

Sign in begins at 8:30 a.m., the first session at 8:55.

There will be six sessions, either 45 or 55 minutes long, with 5 minutes between.

There is no specific lunch session - participants will select a time to eat based on the sessions they wish to attend. Morning coffee and lunch for advisers and speakers will be served in an adviser hospitality room. Students may use the campus center food court or shops to purchase lunch, or bring their own.

The program has been scheduled to end by 2:15 p.m.
