### Schedule info:

Registration begins at 8:30 a.m., the first session at 8:55. The program has been scheduled to end by 2:15 p.m.

There will be six sessions, either 45 or 55 minutes long, with 5 minutes between.

There is no specific lunch session - participants will select a time to eat based on the sessions they wish to attend. Morning coffee and lunch for advisers and speakers will be served in the adviser hospitality room. Students may use the campus center food court or shops within the building to purchase lunch, or bring their own.

### **Write-off Contest:**

One member of each staff may participate in the write-off sponsored by the *Record* newspaper. Immediately following the 9:45 featured speaker's session, participants will report to the contest room where they will write a news story about the presentation.

Judging will be completed and winners announced by the end of the day. Prizes provided by the *Record* will be sent to the school principal at a later date so that a presentation may be made at school.

### On-site Yearbook critique:

Yearbook staffs may also wish to take advantage of the opportunity to have expert feedback through an onsite critique.

Sit down with an expert and review your book - get insight and advice.

You will be allotted a block of up to 30 minutes for a face-to-face discussion with a yearbook expert to go over your book and discuss its strengths and weaknesses.
